



## PACKING HINTS

The climate of the Kimberley lends itself to casual and comfortable clothing. The temperature ranges from 24 degrees to 34 degrees with warm, balmy days and crisp, cool evenings (June – Aug). A windcheater or lightweight jumper will be sufficient to keep the breeze out. The atmosphere on board is casual; there is no dress code for dinner. We prefer guests to have bare feet when inside **K2O**.

Please pack simply and lightly for your Kimberley Adventure in **soft bags**. We must insist on the 10kg luggage allowance per person, especially for those being transferred by plane and helicopter. **We have been informed by the carriers that luggage which exceeds this allowance, will not be loaded onto the aircrafts.**

In tropical conditions, shorts and lightweight shirts are the most comfortable. Loose, long sleeved shirts and optional long pants in a natural, lightweight fabric (e.g. cotton) can offer protection against the sun and insects. There are plenty of opportunities for cooling swims so it is advisable to bring a couple of pairs of bathers/boardies.

### **The following list is designed to help you in preparing for your adventure:**

- Spray Jacket
- Lightweight trousers
- Loose & comfortable shorts
- Shirts/blouses
  - one short and one long sleeved
- Sun hat
  - or may be purchased on board
- Sun glasses
  - it may be advisable to bring an extra pair
- Walking shoes / sneakers / reef sandals
  - sturdy, comfortable and worn in!
- Bathers
  - towels are provided in your cabin
- A warm jumper for the early morning helicopter flight

### **Pack an ample supply of personal basic health and first aid needs:**

- Any prescription drugs or vitamins
- Throat lozenges
- Motion sickness preventative
- Insect Repellent.
- Sunscreen, Chap Stick
- Personal toiletries or hygiene products

### **The following items may come in handy:**

- Binoculars (essential for bird watching)
- Small flashlight
- Small, preferably waterproof bag suitable for carrying camera equipment
- Camera batteries (**K2O** has 240v electricity suitable for re-charging)
- Plenty of camera film or plenty of memory on your digital cameras.
- Favourite (easy listening) CD's / book or magazine
- Personal Water Bottle for taking on excursions (optional, water is supplied)

## **Photography**

**K2O** is equipped with a laptop and card reader which you will be welcome to use. Please ask your crew if you wish to download your photos and burn them onto CD. Disks will be available for purchase on board for \$5 or if you prefer, please bring your own.

## **Fishing Equipment**

We provide our guests with good quality fishing equipment to use on a lost/replacement basis and lures are for sale on board at approximately \$14. Please ask your crew. For the keen angler, please feel free to bring your own fishing gear.

## **Beverages**

Your alcohol can be pre-ordered through the office. (See attached sheet). Please return the form approximately 6 weeks prior to your departure. The prices charged are at Kimberley bottle shop prices and we ask you to kindly settle your account before departure.

If you prefer to bring / send your own alcoholic / non-alcoholic beverages, please call the office to arrange a timely delivery.

**K2O** can produce up to three thousand litres of fresh water at a time; bringing your own water bottle will eliminate the need to order quantities of bottled water.

There is a tea/coffee station available to guests 24 hours a day.

Fruit juices are served with breakfast. If you prefer large quantities of this throughout the day, it is advisable to pre-order your requirements.

Complimentary soft drinks are provided on board - however, if you need mixers or you usually drink a large amount of fizzy drinks, it is preferable to pre-order on the attached form.
